The Leadership, Enrichment, Achievement Program at Frederick Community College is a personal growth and enrichment class for transitioning students and youth with intellectual and developmental disabilities. This course helps students develop positive habits and a proactive approach to life as they design personal mission statements, explore individual talents and gifts, and learn to apply their strengths to the workforce and adult world.



Highlights of LEAP at FCC:

- LEAP is taught by an FCC Adjunct Professor of Psychology.
- Traditional FCC students attend classes to support an inclusive learning environment.
- Each student goes through the FCC registration process and receives a college ID.
- Students receive a voucher for the bookstore to purchase items.
- Students eat lunch in the Cougar Café and participate in campus activities.
- Students who have completed LEAP have also taken other enrichment and credit classes at Frederick Community College.
- LEAP is a collaborative project between The Arc of Frederick County, Frederick Community College and Frederick County Public Schools.
