Areas to consider when planning for your child's future:

Healthcare Decisions— <u>Advance directives</u>; medical decisions can be made without guardianship.

Financial Planning— <u>Special Needs Trust</u>; A properly designed Special Needs Trust protects assists for the use and benefit of a person with a disability while at the same time preserving that persons eligibility for government benefits.

Life Planning— <u>Alternatives to Guardianship; Letter of Intent;</u> There are many creative ways your family can develop a plan for living arrangements for your child when you are no longer able to care for them.

Legal Planning— *Wills;* A Will is important even if you do not have a lot of assets.
