



Apply For LISS Funding December 17, 2014

- WHO:** ANYONE needing assistance with the LISS application process
- WHAT:** The Arc of Frederick County and Infants and Toddlers are providing a day of walk-in service for anyone needing assistance with applying for DDA funds. The Arc and Infant and Toddler staff will be available to help complete forms and answer any questions!
- WHEN:** December 17, 2014 from 12:00pm – 8:00pm
- WHERE:** The Arc of Frederick County, 620A Research Court, Frederick, MD 21703



WHAT TO BRING TO APPLY FOR LISS FUNDING:

- **Invoice or estimate** of what you are looking to have covered for future services (LISS will not cover previous purchased or services received)
- A copy of **social security card**
- **Proof of address** (Maryland ID, front cover of IEP, bills in person's name)

WHAT TO BRING IF YOU ARE APPLYING FOR ADAPTIVE EQUIPMENT OR THERAPIES:

- **Denial from insurance** if applying for adaptive equipment or therapies
- **Doctor recommendation letter** for adaptive equipment or therapies

Below are a few examples of what LISS will cover and additional information needed if applying for Adaptive Equipment or Therapy. LISS provides funding for services and items to help with a specific need. LISS may include, but are not limited to, supports involving:

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| • Individual and family counseling | • Transportation |
| • Personal Care | • Identification Services |
| • Day Care | • Training and Support for Self-Advocacy |
| • Specialized Equipment | • Therapeutic Services (cannot duplicate services offered by the school system) |
| • Health Services | • Medical Equipment Purchase, Rental, Repair |
| • Respite Care | • Crisis Intervention and follow-up |
| • Housing Adaptations | |
