

Autism Waiver Service Coordination Includes 2 Components:

Assessment

- Facilitates eligibility process including financial, technical, and medical
- Coordinates and completes initial assessment and annual reassessment

Ongoing

- Monthly contact with families to review satisfaction of services
- Completes quarterly visits with participant (one visit per year must be an in-home visit)
- Updates to the Plan of Care as needed
- Assists family in obtaining Environmental Accessibility Adaptations for the child's safety
- Assists family with questions regarding Medical Assistance
- Central contact person with Maryland State Department of Education, Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, and Frederick County Public Schools

Your Autism Waiver Service Coordinator may also provide:

- Information and referral to other resources
- Assistance with completing the Medical Assistance application and annual redetermination
- Assistance with completing the Developmental Disabilities Administration application if needed
