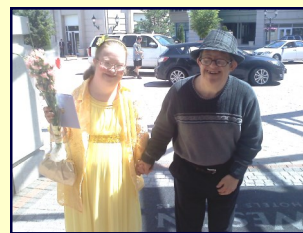




## David Glick 1960~2014
